NO FEES OR INSURANCE WILL BE REQUIRED! Donation by any vendors will be picked up from your location during the event by someone from the Tea Farm. DIRECTIONS TO THE CHARLESTON TEA FARM:

JUST UNDER 20 MILES FROM THE INTERSECTION OF THE J.I. CONNECTOR WITH FOLLY ROAD GO UP FOLLY ROAD TO MAYBANK HIGHWAY TURN LEFT, WEST, AND GO ALL THE WAY ACROSS JOHNS ISLAND, PASS MAIN ROAD, KEEP ON MAYBANK ONTO WADMALAW ISLAND (SMALL BRIDGE) STAY ON MAYBANK, (BEARS LEFT AT A FORK) AND FOLLOW IT ALL WAY ALMOST TO THE TOWN OF ROCKVILLE. THE FARM IS ON THE LEFT, MARKED WITH LIGHT BLUE SIGN.

[NEW EVENT: Summer Celebration - Folly River Park](#) We have reserved the Folly River Park the first Saturday of each month beginning in June and ending in September. The dates are as follows: June 6th, July 4th, August 1st and September 5th.
